The AED Foundation Technical Assessments evaluates student's knowledge of the critical functions outlined in The Standards for Heavy Equipment Technology published by The AED Foundation. The questions as well as the Standards that they are based on were developed by a task force of technical experts from across the industry, including manufacturers, distributors, and educators.

WHO TAKES THE AED FOUNDATION TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT?

The Assessment is designed for college students enrolled in a Heavy Equipment Technology Program. It is an online-based Assessment typically administered at the conclusion of the Program.

Industry Technician Certification

Students can earn an industry recognized certification when scoring 70% or higher that gives them a competitive advantage when entering the heavy equipment industry.

The AED Foundation's Assessment allows educators to analyze benchmarking data in order to evaluate program effectiveness and student learning. The AED Foundation Technical Pre-Assessment can be utilized to measure student growth.
